

ELECTIONEERING

The Board of Education recognizes the right of its employees, as citizens, to engage in political activity, with the following restrictions:

School employees engaged in political activities shall make it clear that any public pronouncement and/or actions are theirs as individuals and that they, in no manner, represent the views of the school district.

School District employees may not participate in partisan electioneering during work hours when students are present in a controlled environment or when other employees are present and are in the course of performing their duties.
