

SCHOOL BOARD LEGAL STATUS

The Board of Education is a seven member board elected by the residents of the district. Each member of the Board shall serve for three years. The terms of office of Board members shall not all expire in the same year. Board members are responsible for school district management and policy making.

The legal status of the Board is that of a corporate body established pursuant to the Laws of New York State. No member of the Board can be held individually liable for actions brought against the school district.
