

STUDENT LIAISON TO THE BOARD

The student representative to the Board of Education shall enjoy all the rights, privileges, responsibilities and recognition of regularly elected trustees including, but not limited to, the right to proper notice of all meetings and distributed materials, a nameplate, and the right to speak in an advisory capacity on any issues which may come before the Board in public session.

The student representative shall not be privy to information regarding district employees, negotiations, or other confidential matters, and shall not have the right to vote. Any abuse by the student representative of rights, privileges, responsibilities or recognition, as determined by a majority of the Board, may result in the dismissal of the student from the Board.

The student representative(s) shall be one high school senior and one high school junior in good standing selected through an appropriate process under the direction of the High School Principal.
